 - b) Date when the nominee left Jamaica;
 - c) Reason/circumstance for migration to UK;
 - d) Issues and challenges encountered in UK and how they were resolved;
 - e) In the UK, please list and explain active and/or passive relationships with people, places and things in Jamaica and UK/Europe/US/Canada etc (examples: charity, voluntary, business, faith, education, training, holiday etc).
- ii) Please list detail of achievements in UK (however small) in chronological order.
- iii) Please note we are unable to return any documents submitted as supporting evidence.
