



PROCEDURES TO BE ADOPTED IN APPLYING FOR A CERTIFICATE OF NO IMPEDIMENT TO MARRIAGE

1. Write a Letter of Request addressed to the

outlining the following:

- a) Name
 - b) Date and place of birth
 - c) Usual place of residence in Jamaica
 - d) Name, address and nationality of the person you intend to marry
 - e) Names and addresses of two (2) Jamaican residents willing to provide references on your behalf. Both persons should complete an Affidavit (available from the Ministry) in the presence of a Justice of the Peace.
2. The letter should be submitted to the Ministry along with the following:
 - a) Your birth certificate (a certified copy issued by the Registrar-General)
 - b) Your Jamaican passport or a certified copy of its first five (5) pages
 - c) A self-made affidavit (copy attached)
 - d) Two (2) passport-sized photographs. Both should be certified by a Justice of the Peace, Notary Public, Commissioner of Oaths or a Jamaican Consular Officer
 - e) A Decree Absolute and/or Death Certificate, if you are divorced or widowed, respectively
